A major collaborative project on the theme of Brazil is already in preparation with community groups, dance schools, local residents, students, conservatories, music schools and batucadas, as well as brass and accordion bands from Lille.

SÉOUL : SÉOUL, VITE, VITE !
Tripostal, Lille

In 40 years, South Korea has become a world economic power. The exhibition, Seoul, Vite, Vite! (Quick, Quick!) will immerse the viewer in the energy, dynamism and hyper-modernity of Seoul but also in popular culture: the artist Choi Jeong Hwa will present a multitude of colourful works. Completely different worlds will succeed each other with artists such as Choe U-Ram and his mysterious creature-machines. Others, such as Do Ho Suh, reference the country's traditional culture but also issues such as the strained relationship with North Korea.

RIO : CARIOCAS!
maison Folie Wazemmes, Lille


A city of contrasts, Rio contains as many singular visions as the city has neighbourhoods and facets. Festivals, varied and intense atmospheres, a constantly changing urban landscape and a new generation of engaged galleries and artists, Rio is a hot-blooded RENAISSANCE city!

The Maison Folie Wazemmes present artists and collectives inspired by the city and the street: the videographers **Dias & Riedweg**, who work on ethnic minorities, favelas and immigration, talents from the **Fabrica Bhering**, a former chocolate factory converted into a large artists' residency, **A Gentil Carioca Gallery**, from the **Maré Favela** but also other young galleries and new venues of artistic creation will be presented in Wazemmes: debates and events, films, shows, concerts and more.

TU DOIS CHANGER TA VIE
Tripostal, Lille

Another world will be accessible at the Tripostal. Tu Dois Changer ta Vie! (You must change your life!) explores themes as diverse as the progress of science, philosophy and new technologies.

With an itinerary designed as a game of chance and choices in which the visitor becomes the main actor.

RENAISSANCE EXHIBITIONS

DÉTROIT

Gare Saint Sauveur, Lille

Amidst the ruins and the total absence of public services, Detroit has been taken over and rethought by its inhabitants. A Do It Yourself approach has developed with community urban farms, new forms of design based on recycled materials, abandoned sites being converted into artist residencies, and so on.

Exhibition:

in partnership with MOCAD, Museum of Contemporary Art of Detroit, lille3000 will present a selection of iconic artists from Detroit: **Greg Faddell, Steven Shaw** and **Cathie Newell**. Through image, sound and large installations, a selection of other artists, including **Scott Hocking** or **Steve Faigenbaum**, will present their visions of the former Motor City and its new faces, breathing new life into the "City of Dreams".

FERME URBAINE

Sounds of Detroit:

Detroit is the birthplace of many musical styles: techno, rhythm and blues, soul, hip-hop, rap and gospel. These styles will be popping up at events all over the city, along a mixing studio at the Gare Saint Sauveur and sets by iconic Detroit DJs including the great Jeff Mills!



The urban farm:

The concept of DIY ("Do it yourself"), notably with regard food production and agriculture, will be developed at the Gare Saint Sauveur with an urban farm that residents can freely participate in (in collaboration with lille-design and Design for Change), making it live and prosper over the months and seasons. From spring 2015, children and adults can get involved. Watch this space!

PHNOM PENH

Musée de l'Hospice Comtesse, Lille

The capital of Cambodia is the only example in modern times of a city that for nearly four years was almost totally abandoned. Today, one finds a concentration of high-level artists in this city that is spectacular for such a small country. Twenty of these artists, representative of the creative power emanating from Phnom Penh, will be present in Lille to celebrate the rebirth of the Cambodian capital. All draw their inspiration from the city, which they express in various forms: video, photography, performances, street art and sculpture.

EINDHOVEN

maison Folie Moulins and CECU, Lille

Eindhoven, a laboratory of modernity and creativity, has reinvented itself through design and new technologies. It is at the heart of the Maison Folie Moulins that we will discover the highlights of cultural life in Eindhoven: **Dutch Design Week**, an ephemeral designer restaurant, iconic artists from the **STRP** international digital arts festival (Bart Hess), DIY workshops, etc.

Eindhoven and Lille makers will share venues, projects and residencies, giving life to a space of emulation and creation to which the public will be invited, and where it will be able to observe, learn and participate.

TEXTIFOOD

Musée d'Histoire Naturelle, Lille

Orange, lemon, pineapple, banana, coconut, nettle, seaweed, mushroom, coffee, rice, soy, corn, beet, wine, beer and shellfish... We eat them, drink them and weave them! Futurotextiles, an exhibition devised by lille3000, presents the world of textiles and its incredible diversity, from fibre to weave through composites and nonwovens. Its brand new module, Textifood, will present textiles made of **fibres, both natural and artificial, derived from animals or plants, part of which are edible and other parts of which are used to create fabrics.**

Rue Faidherbe, Lille

Lille Rio is taking over Rue Faidherbe with the creation of a monumental set composed of floats from former editions of the great Rio Carnival, brought directly from the Citade do Samba. Artistic direction is in the hands of the carnivalesco of the Grande Rio samba school, Fabio Riccardo, winner of the last two carnivals.

The exhibition presents itself as a plunge into a parallel world, a skewed look at the lines of tension and convergence that make it incredibly complex, desirable and unstable.






